
Meanwhile, renovations have launched on an old building near Forman, turning this derelict structure into a hostel for at least

80 female students. In addition, an entirely new hostel for up to 10 single female faculty and staff recently opened on the FCCU campus, providing a safe place to live for young professionals from outside of Lahore.

Also, Forman's Light of Hope School -- established for the children of our service staff -celebrated another landmark, araduatina its first class of 15 students. Having completed the US equivalent of grade 10, these araduates will now continue their studies at either Kinnaird (for girls) or Forman (for boys), becoming the first in their families to attend college.

Finally, let me give a special shoutout to Sam Schreiner as he transitions to retirement.

Sam's roots in what is now Pakistan go back nearly a century, and he too will leave an


Special Announcement from the Board:



FROM STUDENT TO SCHOLAR THE KENETH PERVAIZ STORY

In 2007, I met with two bright young students when my fellow traveler, John Marr, snapped this photo of the three of us. Keneth Pervaiz was the student to my left. He was a math major, but he wanted to know how to become a pastor. He came from a family of humble means; Keneth lost his father when he was 15. **His mother took out a**

loan using her jewelry as collateral so he could enroll at Forman Christian College. After his first semester, the administration saw his potential, and awarded him a full scholarship.



Keneth had a heart for ministry and was active in the chapel program. Dr. Bob Wetmore, Professor of New Testament at Forman, became his mentor. After graduating from Forman in 2009, Dr. Wetmore encouraged Keneth to pursue Biblical Studies. He then found a sponsor to underwrite Keneth's master's program in New Testament Theology at Queens University in Ireland. Upon graduation in 2012, Keneth wrote to Dr. Jim Tebbe (then rector), seeking a position in which to serve at Forman. Dr. Tebbe offered the opportunity to assist in the chapel and teach Christian Ethics to university students.

While his focus was teaching the young men, he fell in love with a young woman during their work together at the chapel. Keneth's future wife, Aroona, was the leader of the Christian student association at Forman, and they felt the Lord had brought them together to be lifelong partners.



Keneth knew he needed a Ph.D. to have a broader impact in Pakistan. Dr. Wetmore found someone who supported Keneth's Greek and New Testament doctoral studies at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, KY. Aroona joined



him once they were married and supported them until she graduated with her master's degree in counseling, and he completed his Ph.D. in 2021 - all while welcoming their daughter Amelia into the family!

Today Keneth's and Aroona's lives have come full circle. They have returned to Lahore, where Keneth is an Associate Professor of Religious Studies at Forman Christian College. He is teaching Greek, advising students, and occasionally preaching at the church on campus. As the only Pakistani in the country with an earned Ph.D. in New Testament, Keneth also works on a curriculum for Christians enrolled in government-run elementary and secondary schools. Keneth's remarkable story of moving from student to scholar with the support of many others reminds us that Forman Christian College is making an essential contribution to Pakistan and people of faith, one life at a time.


FCCU 5 YEAR GROWTH


