A NOTE FROM FORMAN CHRISTIAN COLLEGE

What a joy it was to see students return to campus on June 7 to start the final four weeks of the 2021 spring semester! While limited numbers of faculty and staff continued to work on campus all year, students -- the heart of any university -- were notable by their physical absence.

In fact, only university students with "even" ID numbers returned in June while those with "odd" ID numbers continued to receive instruction on-line. Two weeks later, roles were reversed, highlighting the main features of a "blended" system involving in-person and on-line instruction.

While 2020-2021 will always be remembered as a year

dominated by COVID-19, the Forman family demonstrated its resilience in many gratifying ways. Importantly, Forman was ranked by Pakistan's Higher Education Commission (HEC) as one of the top universities in the country in terms of its ability to provide on-line instruction.

Friends of Forman who have contributed to strengthening Forman's IT systems in recent years played a big part in this success. At the same time, the generosity displayed during the Friends COVID-19 appeal raising almost \$40,000 in emergency funds also helped so many.

Relying on the Pakistan public health system to provide free vaccines, Friends of Forman emergency funds were used for a range of other pandemic-related purposes including educational materials, testing, protective gear and related equipment for Mercy Health Center. Separately, scholarship funding was directed toward students and families directly affected by COVID-19.

Looking ahead, Forman's enrollment and budget situation are both in an encouraging place as we find our way through the pandemic. Looking back, we are grateful for your prayerful support through Friends of Forman which has made this possible.






