

Noor has published her research paper in the International Journal of Food Properties (Impact Factor 2.90, QI Cite Score Best Quartile, HEC Recognized W Category Journal). This research highlighted the effects of germination on the phytochemical and antioxidant properties of black chickpeas in response to increment in germination time. It concluded that extended germination for 120 hours can negatively influence the phytochemical and antioxidant profile of black chickpeas; however, optimum germination for 72 hours was found promising in positively enhancing the bioactive traits of black chickpeas in comparison to non-germinated black chickpeas.

Faseeh Ahmed got selected for Supporting Preparedness for Article 6 Cooperation (SPAR6C) Research Mentorship Program (RMP). SPAR6C is the largest and more comprehensive program of Article 6 of the Paris agreement to foster development of the carbon market. He did his research, followed by an internship under this program.

Hadiya provided a strategic solution to reduce losses in the supply chain of fresh tomatoes in Pakistan. Her research entailed different surveys that led her to identify the root causes of this problem. She concluded that the plastic packaging along with pre-cooled tomatoes kept under refrigeration, indicated the best physicochemical attributes and extended shelf life. By implementing the proposed strategic measures, the agriculture sector can mitigate challenges, optimize resource utilization, and contribute to the economic growth of the country.

MS. JAWARIA AMIN Majors in Food Safety & Quality Management



Jawaria, along with her co-inventor, has invented a smart edible paper that changes its color in response to a change in pH and multiple heating episodes of food products, indicating the product safety status. Furthermore, this smart edible paper can indicate the shelf life of the food product as well. The paper is biodegradable and leaves no pollution signature when disposed after use. Jawaria and her co-inventor have invested a whole year to crack the code to master this craft. This technology is under consideration for a patent.

Jawaria developed prebiotic-enriched jellies to boost gut microbiota. She investigated the physiochemical properties and prebiotic activity score of obtained oligosaccharides for the production of prebiotic-enriched jellies. She proved that oligosaccharides from citrus peels hold significant prebiotic effect and the prebiotic activity score for *Bifidobacterium* was higher than *L. reuteri* and both probiotic bacteria support the growth of each other. The citrus peel prebiotic limits the growth of *E. coli* while the growth of *E. coli* is retarred by the co-culture microbial system. Her findings support the production of synbiotic foods for gut microbiome modulation.
