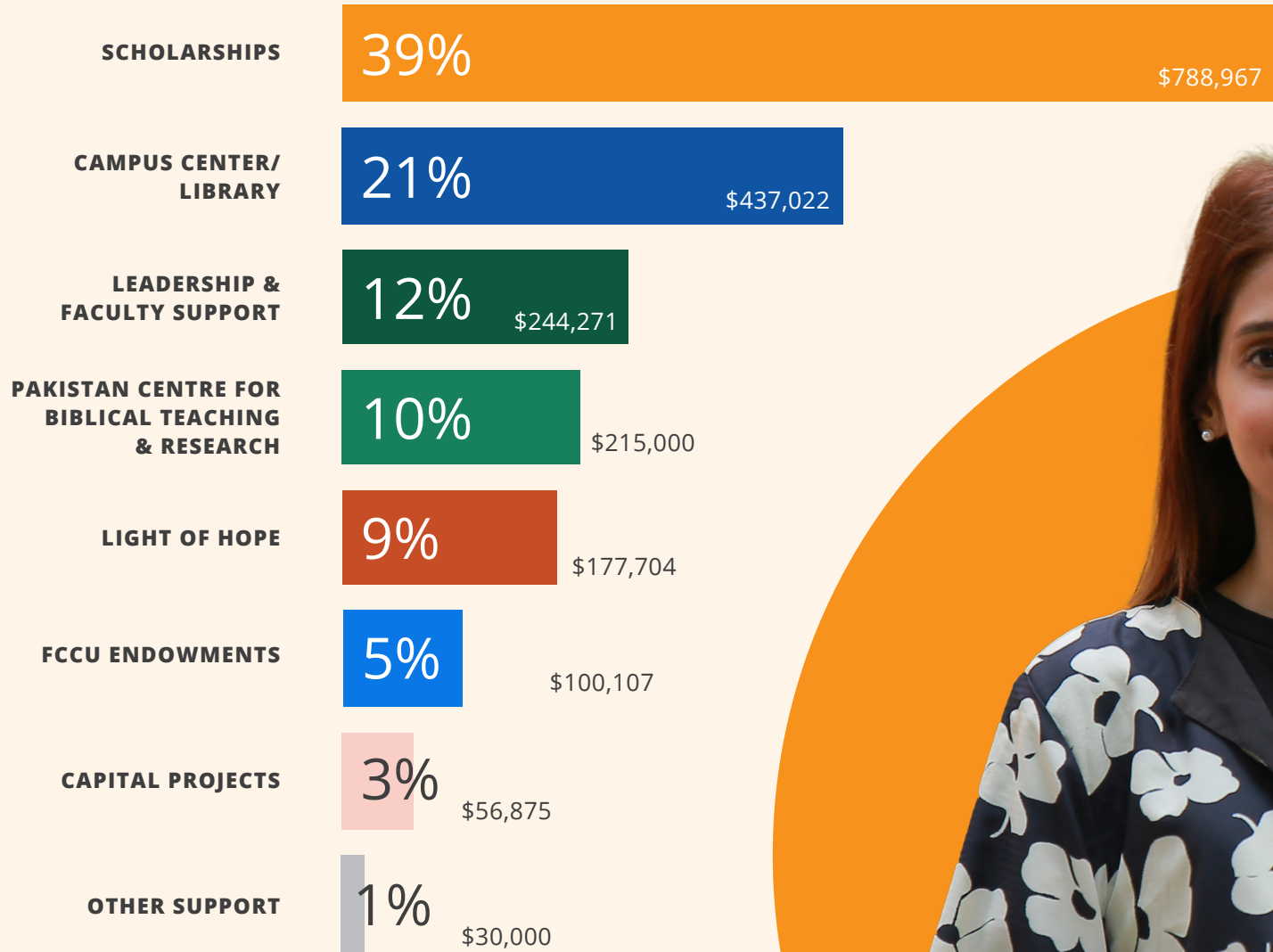

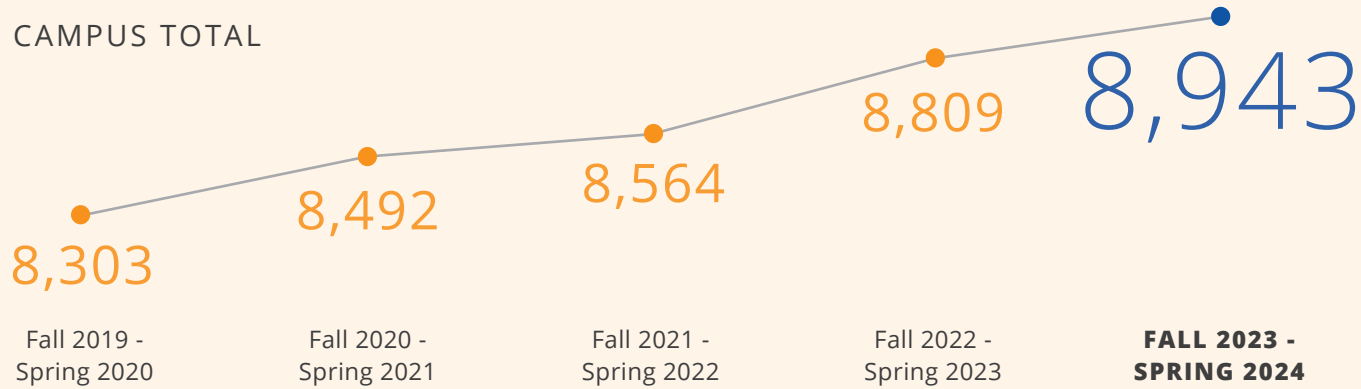

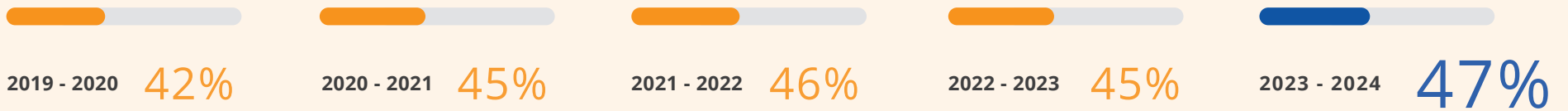


## FORMAN ENROLLMENT

CAMPUS TOTAL

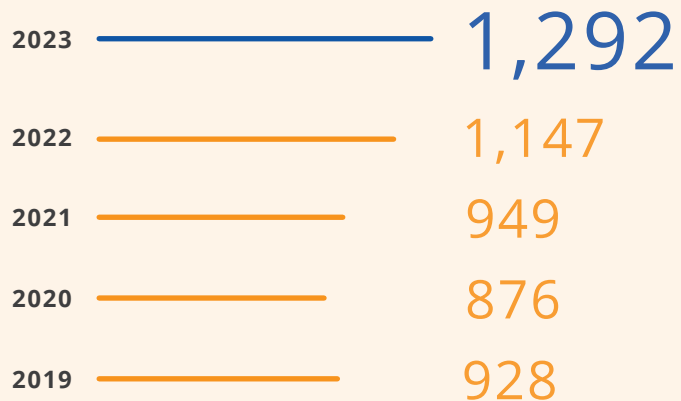


## WOMEN ENROLLED

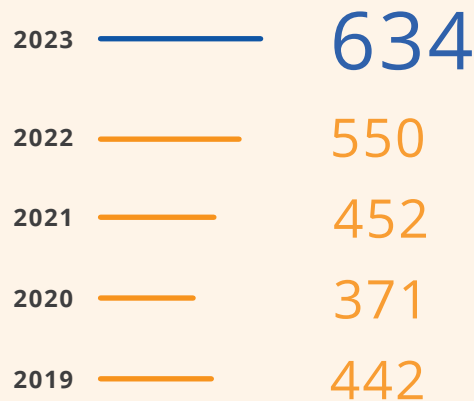


## FORMAN GRADUATION

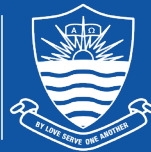
