PLANNING YOUR TRIP

Is it safe to travel to Pakistan

While Pakistan has areas of concern, Lahore is considered one of the country's most secure cities. The campus itself is gated, guarded, and has security staff across the campus.

How will I know when to fly and which airports to fly into?

Most flights from the U.S. to Lahore involve one or two layovers, typically in cities like Doha, Istanbul, or Dubai.

We provide each guest with specific instructions on departure and return dates. Most itineraries depart in the evening of Day One and arrive in the very early morning of Day Three. Most return trips happen within the same calendar day.

Your destination is Lahore's Allama Iqbal International Airport (LHE). The airport is about 25–30 minutes by car from FCCU's campus.

We make every effort to accommodate church pastors so they only miss one Sunday back home. Some have even recorded a live-feed video from campus back to their congregation. A typical schedule might depart on a Monday and return the following Monday or Tuesday.

DOCUMENTS & HEALTH

Do I need a passport?

Yes. Check the expiration date on your U.S. passport before planning your trip, you must have a minimum of six months remaining before expiration in order to travel.

Do I need a visa?

Yes, U.S. citizens require a tourist visa to visit Pakistan. We provide specific instructions to walk you through the online process.

Do I need any vaccinations?

No specific vaccines are required, but we recommend consulting the CDC website and your personal physician.

ON THE GROUND

What language is spoken?

English is commonly spoken in major institutions like FCCU, making navigation easier for foreign guests.

What is the weather like?

Lahore has a hot semi-arid climate.

- Spring and fall are the ideal times of year to visit.

Where will we stay?

There is a modern, secure, comfortable guest house on campus. Each bedroom has its own bathroom and shower.

How do we travel in and around Lahore?

FCCU's drivers provide all transportation in campus-owned vans or buses.

DAILY ACTIVITIES

What kinds of things will we be doing each day?

A specific schedule will be provided several weeks before departure, which you can share with family and prayer partners. Each trip typically includes most of the following:

- Structured and casual time to talk with both Christian and Muslim students on campus.
- Participation in events put on by student clubs, typically as their guests of honor.
- Meetings with key senior leadership (and likely dining opportunities as well).
- The weekly campus chapel service and Sunday Worship service with the Presbyterian Church of Pakistan.
- Free time to explore the botanical gardens, athletic fields, and architectural courtyards on campus.
- A visit to the home of a Christian student, meeting their family and seeing what village life is like for many.
- Time at some of Lahore's culturally and architecturally significant sites, followed by a brief window for souvenir shopping.
